Dear Poster Presenter,

We wish to have a record number of posters at the FPRW in 2010, and we are going to give a prize to the author(s) of the poster that receives the most votes from the attendees.

The posters will be displayed from Monday morning until Wednesday at noon during the meeting. The posters will be divided into 3 groups, and authors will be asked to stand by their posters for an hour each morning depending on their group. The winner will be announced and prize given at the end of the meeting on Wednesday.

Furthermore, you are encouraged to contribute an article to the *Journal of Agricultural and Food Chemistry* (JAFC) as part of a special section related to FPRW 2010. The manuscripts must be submitted electronically online on the JAFC website by the deadline to be announced (expected to be Sept. 1, 2010). Submitted manuscripts will undergo the normal peer-review process to determine if it is acceptable for publication.

There are a limited number of slots available for talks and posters. The deadline for oral presentation abstracts is May 1, 2010 and June 1, 2010 for poster abstracts. The author will have a choice of preference for talk, poster, or either. The program committee will make the decisions on talks by May 10 and posters by June 10, at which time you will receive word if your submission is accepted. Last minute poster submissions after the deadlines will be allowed depending on availability of slots, but your abstract may not appear in the program book in that case. You must register for the meeting by June 15 if you wish to keep your slot.

Poster boards will be 4 feet high by 6 feet wide. We will provide push pins and envelopes to receive reprint requests. The boards will be set up on Sunday evening in the exhibition area, which will give you a number of opportunities to hang your poster: FPRW registration begins on Sunday at 5:00 PM.
