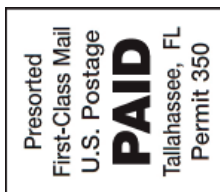

Chemical Residue Method Development, Validation and Routine Analysis

This 2-day course provides introductory training in methods to determine pesticide and veterinary drug residues in food and the environment. The methods covered include multi-residue and single residue methods using mass spectrometric techniques. Emphasis is given to the critical steps required for successful method development, validation and implementation for residue monitoring and control. The course will include material on sample preparation and processing, extraction and clean-up and the determination by GC-MS and LC-MS techniques. The training will also cover analytical quality control and validation of methods in accordance with relevant regulations and standards. FDA/STATE ROUND TABLE
