There is a proposed new subgroup of the Chemical Contaminants and Residues in Foods Community focusing on water and wastewater contaminants being developed. This subgroup's goals will be to:

1. Develop consensus methods for emerging and new contaminants found in water and wastewater. These contaminants are not only the pollutants of concern found in EPA notices, but are also are chemical compounds that will become target analytes in the future.
2. Modify current AOAC approved methods for chemical contaminants found in water or wastewater matrixes.
3. Update legacy AOAC water and wastewater methods to the current regulatory performance requirements.
